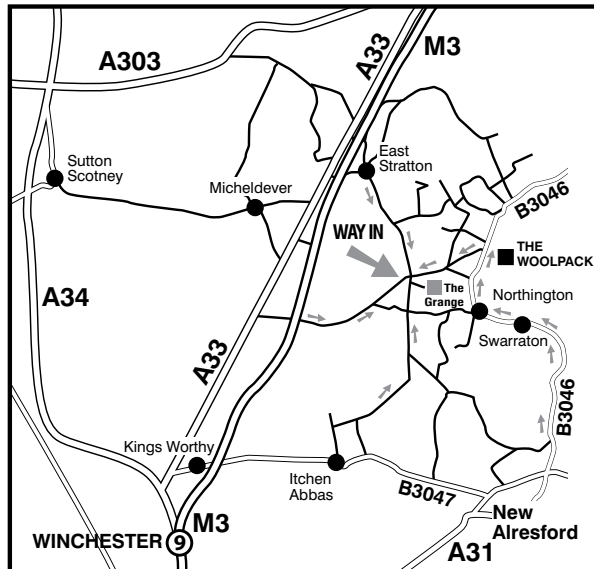

## THE CANDOVER VALLEY SPONSORED RIDE

The ride will be approximately 8 miles over farm and parkland, through woods and water meadows. There are approximately 40 flagged fences — both large and small — with a range of alternatives. **No fence has to be jumped.** A free soft drink is provided at the half-way point.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All riders **must** wear crash hats and body protectors are recommended.

Horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Only 3 attempts allowed at one jump. Passing is allowed on the course.

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, the organisers do not accept any liability for any accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, landowners or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

Failure to carry out instructions from a steward may lead to dismissal from the course. The decision of the Committee on any matter is final.

Paramedics will be on site.

### ENTRIES AND SPONSORSHIP

This is not a competition and it is anticipated that everyone will be able to complete the course.

ENTRY FEE\* per person (non refundable) £12.00 which includes £2 for paramedic cover. **\*Same as last year.**

PLUS minimum sponsorship £20.00 per rider OR if a family of 4 or more, minimum sponsorship £15.00 per rider.
